  4. Chemical Restraint (if indicated)
  5. Vital signs
  6. Appropriate trauma care destination selection

RUBBER BULLETS, BEAN BAG PROJECTILES)</p> <p>TRAUMA AND HYPOVOLEMIC SHOCK SUPPORTIVE CARE</p> <p>TREAT PER OTHER APPLICABLE SECTION 10 PROTOCOLS - TRAUMA</p> <p>TREAT PER APPLICABLE SECTION 7 PROTOCOLS – PSYCHIATRIC/BEHAVIORAL DISORDERS</p> <p>APPLY CARDIAC MONITOR/OBTAIN 12-LEAD ECG (if equipped)</p> <p>TRANSMIT 12-LEAD ECG TO RECEIVING EMERGENCY DEPARTMENT</p> <p><b>EMT OR HIGHER LICENSE:</b></p> <p>MEASURE END – TIDAL CO<sub>2</sub> &amp; MONITOR WAVEFORM CAPNOGRAPHY (if equipped, ** Mandatory use if pt intubated)</p>

<p><b>ADULT:</b> MEDICATION ASSISTED INTUBATION IF INDICATED</p> <p>CHEMICAL RESTRAINT IF INDICATED PER PROTOCOL 7C – CHEMICAL RESTRAINT</p> <p>CONTINUOUS ASSESSMENT &amp; TREATMENT PER APPLICABLE PROTOCOL(S)</p>
